### Registration Process

1. Complete the Pre-Advising Worksheet using the above information and your degree template, and turn it in to Dr. Lamm Bray. Worksheet is available on Eagle Salem.
2. Make an appointment to meet with Dr. Lamm Bray (must be at least 24 hours after you turned in the worksheet).
3. After your advising meeting with Dr. Lamm Bray, she will clear you to register.
4. Complete Pre-Registration in Self-Service.
5. Complete Registration in Self-Service.
