RATIONALE – The faculty of the Business Administration major desires that all undergraduate business students fulfill their graduation requirements in a satisfactory and timely fashion. Therefore, the following admission to major criteria has been established to provide clear and consistent advising guidelines.

ADMISSION TO MAJOR CRITERIA

- Formal Application (Spring semester of the Sophomore year)
- Junior Standing (60 credits)
- Cum GPA 2.75 (within Business Major Lower Core)
- Completion of Lower Core
- Complete Pre-Calculus with a grade of C- or better
- Interview as Requested (Spring semester of the Sophomore year)

FOR SECOND SEMESTER SOPHOMORES

Admission applications are sent out one month before fall registration of their Junior year. Students are to complete the application and return to their faculty advisor one week before they are able to register for fall semester. All second semester sophomore students are expected to complete all admission to major requirements by the end of their sophomore year.

- If they do complete all requirements – student is admitted into the major.
- If they do not complete all requirements – student is placed on provisional status and must complete all requirements by the end of their Junior year.
- Students will not be allowed to register for any upper division business courses during their Senior year until they have satisfied the admission criteria.

TRANSFER STUDENTS

Admission to major applications are given to all Junior level (60 credits) transfer students before they register for their first semester at Northwest University. Students are to complete the application and return it to their faculty advisor before registration. All transfer students are expected to complete all admission to major requirements before they register for their first semester.

- If they do complete all requirements – student is admitted into the major.
- If they do not complete all requirements – student is placed on provisional status and must complete all requirements by the end of their Junior year.
- Students will not be allowed to register for any upper division business courses during their senior year until they have satisfied the admission criteria.
