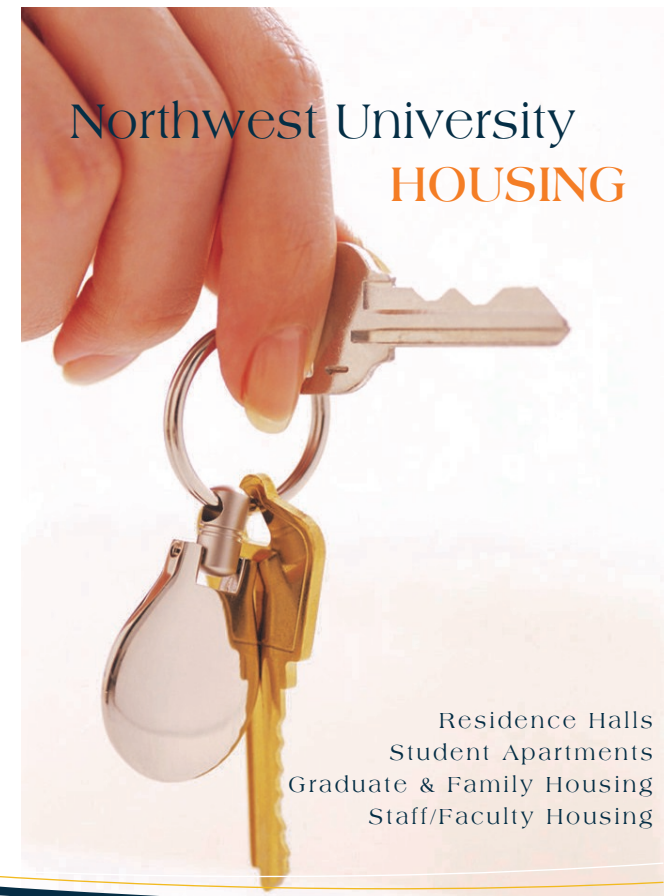
EASY APPLICATION PROCESS

- **TURN IN A HOUSING APPLICATION**
Applications may be found on the housing website <http://eagle.northwestu.edu/housing>
- **INCLUDE \$25 APP FEE**
If you are applying for Family/GRAD/LEAP Housing in the Firs or Student Apartments.
- **PAY THE \$300 DEPOSIT***
Traditional Students applying for the Residence Halls and Student Apartments should include this with their application. Family housing residents will have 7 days to pay this once they are offered a unit.
- **PLACEMENT CONFIRMATION SENT**
Semester applicants will receive a placement confirmation in their NU e-mail. Monthly applicants will receive an offer letter prior to an official placement.

COMPETITIVE COST, COMMUNITY & CONVIENENCE

Housing is split into 2 categories - Semester paying and monthly paying status. All students are automatically under our semester Status, unless they are married, a grad Student, or over the age of 23 .

Traditional Student Housing (Semester paid status)

Residence Halls

Northwest University residence halls offer a diverse community of incoming first year students through our seasoned upperclassmen. We have 5 buildings with a capacity of 510 students. Each floor comprises of approx. 20 rooms with centralized bathrooms. Both the men's and women's halls have a large lounge area with cable television, activities and room to socialize. Rates below are per semester and include one 15x11 room, a full meal plan, utilities and furnishings.

**Premium rooms have additional square footage and closet space. If a premium double room has 3 residents the semester charge will be adjusted to \$3,186.00 per resident.*

Student Apartments

Northwest University student apartments offer a community of students 21 and older and upperclassmen. The student apartments offer furnished, spacious apartments located on the upper east campus. Within a semester program all utilities including electric, cable television, phone and internet service are included. Double occupancy per room is expected.

Firs Apartments

Northwest University Firs apartments offers a community of families, Leap professionals and graduate students. Single traditional students above the age of 23 may also apply. The Firs comprise of 78 apartments located on the upper east campus. Priced with the student family in mind, The Firs are on average 10-25% less than apartments in the Kirkland/Bellevue area.
