

Welcome to Northwest University Housing!

We are excited that you have made the choice to attend Northwest University! As you are aware, we are a residential campus with the belief that education is enhanced by the living-learning communities students experience when living on campus. ***It is proven that students who live on campus form lasting relationships and achieve a greater level of sustained learning and academic success.*** To facilitate this type of success, all students are required to live on campus their first 2 years and until they are 21 years old and reach junior status.

Residence Halls: For our 18-25 year old single residents within our standard housing option, we offer fully furnished room, utilities included, wireless internet, inviting lounge spaces with Comcast Cable, all you can eat meals in The Caf, \$100 flex dollars in The Aerie café, and a dynamic residential life program.

Residence Hall Private Package (single occupancy, per semester, per person, approval required)*	\$4,726

* Private room requests are not guaranteed and are only available as space allows.

Student Apartments: Within our Student Apartment package, we offer fully furnished apartments with all utilities paid, including Internet and cable. This package is a popular option for our 20-25 year old single residents who desire an apartment style living environment. The student apartments are filled by returning students each spring; **new students can request to be put on a wait list when filling out their housing application.**

Family Housing (FIRS): For our married students, students with families, or students 25 years and older, we offer a monthly affordable apartment option. All of our apartment units include phone service, wireless internet, water, sewer, and garbage.

FIRS Apartment (1 bedroom, 1 bath, per month)	\$740
FIRS Apartment (2 bedroom, 1 bath, per month)	\$850
FIRS Apartment (2 bedroom, 2 bath, per month)	\$950

Residential Exemption Request: Students wishing to live off campus **must** complete an online Residential Exemption Request indicating which of the criteria they meet:

- Live with their parent(s) or an approved adult's residence
- 23 years old or older on the first day of class
- Be 21 years old AND have junior status (60 semester credits earned) on the first day of class
- Be married and living off campus
- Have been approved to study abroad
- Have a job off campus, which provides room and board

Here's how to apply:

1. Access the NU Housing page at: <http://eagle.northwestu.edu/departments/housing>
2. Login at the top of the page with your NU email address and NU student number as your password.

Example:

3. Click on the large "My Housing" image at the top of the page.
4. Select an application from the drop down menu (New Student Application).
5. Read and Sign the Agreement, then click "**Continue**".
6. Answer the questions on the **Personal Information** page and pay the **\$150** non-refundable Housing Placement fee electronically.

Other important info:

- **Register for classes!** To receive an on campus housing assignment, you must have a housing application, placement fee AND be registered for classes. If you are not registered for classes, you will not receive a housing placement.
- **All** students must either have a housing application on file or an approved Residential Exemption Request as a NU student.
- To apply for FIRS housing, please email housing@northwestu.edu to receive an application and further information.
- Housing assignments will be sent to your NU email address!
