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IMPORTANT RESPONSIBILITIES FOR CONCURRENT CREDIT INSTRUCTORS

If your course is approved by Northwest University, you have important responsibilities to perform as an instructor on behalf of the University. If you have questions about the process, please contact the Concurrent Credit Office at concurrentcredit@northwestu.edu.

- 1. First-time adjunct instructors: Submit a current vita/resume and transcripts that indicate competency and experience in the area to be taught.
- 2. Request a Northwest University course syllabus for the class you intend to teach. Prepare and submit your course syllabus and assessments, including a final assignment rubric using NU's rubric template, to the concurrent credit office for department review and approval. You must receive course approval from NU prior to publicizing your class. Syllabus should include:
 - a) Evidence that the course content and rigor is equivalent to the course taught at the University
 - b) Educational goals for the course
 - c) Student learning objectives and course requirements (both in and out of class)
 - d) Student competencies expected upon completion of the course
 - e) Due dates for completion of course requirements
 - f) Learning resources and required texts, including where they can be located
 - g) Evaluation procedures and criteria for grading
- 3. Distribute a syllabus in writing to each student at the beginning of the first class session.
- 4. Conducting Classes: You are expected to maintain high academic standards and to conduct challenging and rewarding classes consistent with course objectives as stated in the syllabus.
- 5. Grading Students: Use the University computer grade sheet for recording final grades and submit the form promptly following the completion of the course.
- 6. Maintaining Quality: Northwest University is a Christian University and has high standards of excellence. Please help us maintain our reputation as a quality educational leader.

Northwest University is a Christian University. If my course is approved, I intend to uphold the quality, standards, and institutional purposes of NU. I understand this includes: (1) using language that is free from profane or vulgar reference; (2) demonstrating respect for the religious beliefs of NU, its faculty, and students; and (3) refraining from the use of tobacco, alcohol, or illegal drugs while relating to Northwest University programming and students.
