

## Application Level Questionnaire

### Institutional Review Board

There are two levels of IRB application: full and abbreviated (often called "the short form"). Answer the following questions about your study; if the answer to any question(s) is *yes*, you must use the full form. Otherwise, use the short form.

1. Will participants be video or audio recorded?
2. Will participants be identifiable to anyone other than the researcher(s)?
3. If participation or responses were known beyond the research project, could participants be at risk of criminal or civil liability, damage to employment, financial loss, or undue embarrassment?
4. Does this research project deal with sensitive topics (i.e. illegal behavior, drug/alcohol use, or sexual conduct)?
5. Does this research project use existing data sources not publicly available (documents, records, specimens etc.)?
6. Will participants be deceived in any way?
7. Does this research project involve participants who are under 18 years old?
8. Does the research project involve participants who are not healthy adults (mentally, physically, or emotionally)?
9. Does this research project involve prisoners, pregnant women, developmentally disabled adults, or any other special population?
10. Does the research project involve any medical or dietary procedures?
