- [Check your NU email](#) – Click “Student Email” at the top of Eagle. Please check your email regularly throughout your time as an NU student.
- [Check out Self-Service](#) – Where NPP students manage their student accounts and find textbooks.
- [Check out My Profile](#) – Where NPP students check if bills are paid or outstanding.
- [Order Your Textbooks](#) – Textbooks can take up to 10 days to arrive. We always recommend Kindle.
- [Contact NPP Financial Services](#) (nppfinancialservices@northwestu.edu) if you have an outstanding balance on your student account to make a plan to pay it off. You will not be able to register for next semester until this semester is paid off.
- [Complete your Academic Success Plan](#) – Your coordinator will hand this out during Orientation or the first study hall.
