- <u>Log into Eagle</u> Where you access all your NU accounts.
- Check your NU email Click "Student Email" at the top of Eagle. Please check your email regularly throughout your time as an NU student.
- <u>Check out Self-Service</u> Where NPP students manage their student accounts and find textbooks.
- Check out My Profile Where NPP students check if bills are paid or outstanding.
- Order Your <u>Textbooks</u> Textbooks can take up to 10 days to arrive. We always recommend Kindle.
- Contact NPP Financial Services (<u>nppfinancialservices@northwestu.edu</u>) if you have an
 outstanding balance on your student account to make a plan to pay it off. You will not be able
 to register for next semester until this semester is paid off.
- Complete your Academic Success Plan Your coordinator will hand this out during Orientation or the first study hall.
- Check out your <u>NU Online courses</u> NU online is for all NPP classes.
 You should have access about a week before the class starts. Message your professor.
 Check out the class. Maybe even get a head start on the reading (the first assignment is due the first Wednesday).
