



## NPP Cost Sheet

The list below describes the costs for both fall and spring semesters combined for a full-time student taking 12 credits in the fall and 12 credits in the spring semesters. Textbooks and miscellaneous expenses are not included.

### Program Costs (2026-2027)

### Ministry Practicum

Full-time students enroll for at least 24 credits for the academic year and may receive 6 additional credits per year by participating in the NPP Partner's internship program when approved by NU and overseen by NPP Coordinator. Part-time students are eligible for practicum credit as well.
