## WELCOME TO NORTHWEST UNIVERSITY HOUSING!

We are excited that you have made the choice to attend Northwest University! As you are aware, we are a residential campus with the belief that education is enhanced by the living-learning communities students experience when living on campus. ***It is proven that students who live on campus form lasting relationships and achieve a greater level of sustained learning and academic success.*** To facilitate this type of success, all full-time, unmarried, undergraduate students 25 and under are required to live on campus.

### RESIDENCE HALLS

For our 18- to 25-year-old single residents within our standard housing option, we offer a fully furnished room with utilities included, wireless internet, inviting lounge spaces with Comcast cable, all-you-can-eat meals in The Caf, 100 flex dollars in the Aerie Café, and a dynamic residential life program.

- Residence Hall Standard Package (double occupancy, per semester, per person) **\$4,500**
- Residence Hall Private Package (single occupancy, per semester, per person, approval required)\* **\$5,400**

*\*Private room requests are not guaranteed and are only available as space allows per medical need.*

### STUDENT APARTMENTS

Within our student apartment package, we offer fully furnished apartments with all utilities paid, including internet and 100 flex dollars in the Aerie Café. This package is a popular option for our 20- to 25-year-old single residents who desire an apartment-style living environment. The student apartments are filled by returning students each spring; **new students can request to be put on a wait list when filling out their housing application.**

- Student Apartment Package (four-person apartment, per semester, per person) **\$2,820**
- Student Apartment Package (six-person apartment, per semester, per person) **\$2,340**

### FAMILY HOUSING: FIRS (FAMILY IN RESIDENCE)

For our married students, students with families, or students 25 years and older, we offer a monthly affordable apartment option. All of our apartment units include phone service, wireless internet, water, sewer, and garbage.

### RESIDENTIAL EXEMPTION REQUEST

Students wishing to live off campus **must** complete an online Residential Exemption Request indicating which of the criteria they meet:

- Student lives with their parent(s) or legal guardian(s) (verification required)
- Student is 23 years old or older on the first day of class
- Student is 21 years old and has junior status (60 semester credits earned) on the first day of class
- Student is married and living off campus
- Student has been approved to study abroad

## HOW TO APPLY

1. Access the NU Housing page at [eagle.northwestu.edu/departments/housing](http://eagle.northwestu.edu/departments/housing).
2. Log in at the top of the page with your NU email address and NU student number as your password.

3. Click on the large “[My Housing](#)” image at the top of the page.
4. Select an application from the drop-down menu (New Student Application).
5. Read and sign the agreement, then click “[Continue.](#)”
6. Complete the application questions, then click “[Continue.](#)”
7. Complete the “[Secure Payment Form](#)” to pay the \$150 non-refundable housing placement fee electronically, then click “[Process Payment.](#)”

## OTHER IMPORTANT INFO

- Register for classes! To receive an on-campus housing assignment, you must have a housing application, placement fee, and be registered for classes. If you are not registered for classes, you will not receive a housing placement.
- All students must either have a housing application on file or an approved Residential Exemption Request as a NU student.
- To apply for FIRs housing, please complete the FIRs Student Application online and pay the \$25 application fee.
- Housing assignments will be sent to your NU email address!
