
EARLY ARRIVALS

1. How do I find out if I'm on the early arrivals list?
Communication will come from your coach or supervisor.
2. How do I check-in?
You will be given instructions from your coach or supervisor with a date and time to check in. At that time, an RA will be available to give you the proper paperwork and issue you a door code or key. Room Condition Inventories (RCI) must be turned back into your RA.
3. Is there visitation?
No. During the early arrival housing period, we do not allow visitation.
4. Are there overnight guests?
No. There are no overnight guests during the early arrival period.
5. Who should I contact if I need something?
You can contact Security at 425.889.5500 or get in touch with your coach or supervisor.
6. How thorough should I be when filling out a Room Condition form?
The Room Condition Form will be used for checking out of your living area. You will be fined for any damages not written down, so it is in your best interest to be very detailed.
7. What if my room is not clean? Or if something in my room needs to be fixed?
