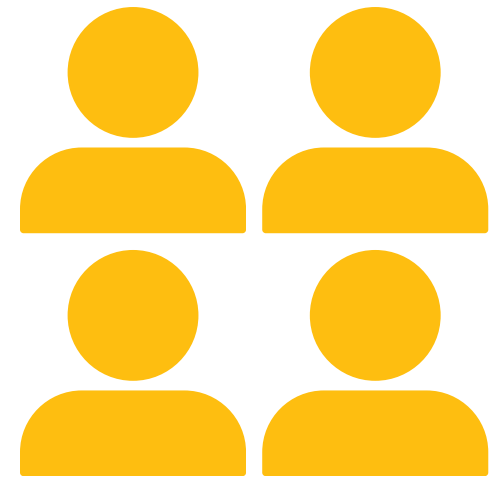

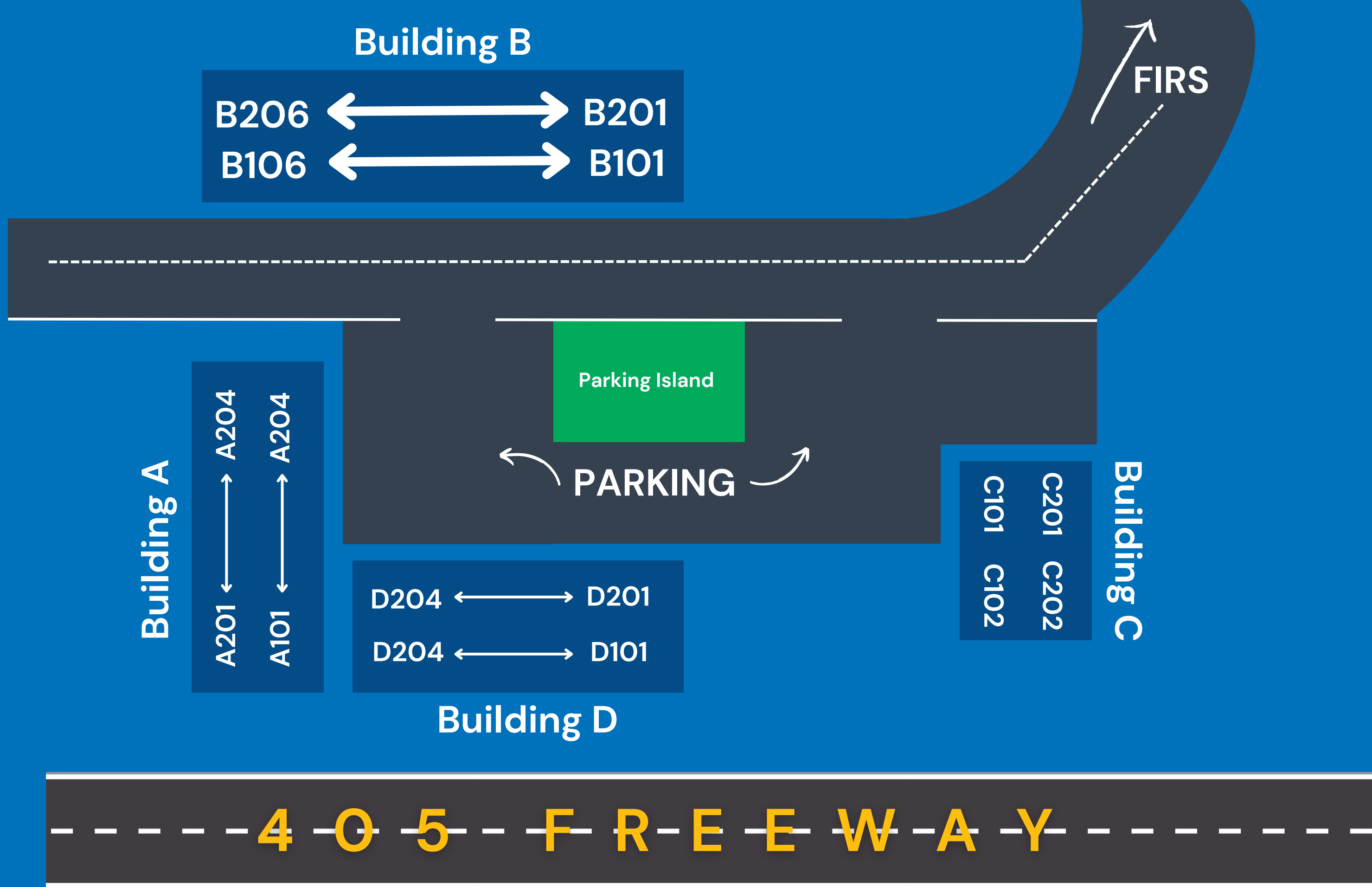

Fill Out Student Apartment Application

Each person in your group must fill out an application by **Thursday, April 16th at noon**

Complete Housing Intent Form

Everyone in your group must fill out the Fall 265 Housing Intent Form by **Thursday, April 16th at noon**

Register for Fall 26 Classes

In order to be eligible for an apartment, you must be registered for Fall 26 classes by **Thursday, April 16th at NOON**

**YOUR
RESPONSIBILITY**

POINT SYSTEM

AGE

20–21 = 2 points
22–23 = 4 points
24–25 = 6 points

ACADEMIC CLASS

Freshman = 2 points
Sophomore = 4 points
Junior = 6 points
Senior = 8 points

SEMESTERS

1.5 points for each semester you have been **enrolled full-time on campus** as a student at NU including current semester

*YOU WILL BE NOTIFIED VIA EMAIL IF YOU HAVE BEEN SELECTED FOR AN APARTMENT WITH A TIME SLOT TO SELECT YOUR APARTMENT. IF YOU DO NOT MAKE IT INTO THE APARTMENTS, YOU WILL BE SENT A SELECTION TIME TO CHOOSE A ROOM IN A RESIDENCE HALL.



A FEW THINGS TO BE AWARE OF:

IF YOU DON'T GET IN A 6 – PERSON

You have the option to down size to a 4-person apartment. You will indicate this on your apartment application.

MEAL PLAN

You will be required to be on a 75-block meal plan with \$125 flex dollars when living in the apartments.

NO GRANDFATHERING

If you currently live in an apartment you are **NOT** guaranteed an apartment next year.

IF YOU DON'T GET IN THE APARTMENTS

You will be invited to choose a room in a residence hall during housing selection night.

INCOMPLETE FORMS OR REGISTRATION

If someone in your apartment group does not get registered in time or complete the required forms, their points will **NOT** count toward your groups points.

MUST BE 20

You must be 20 years old by **August 31, 2026**, to qualify. If you add in someone who does not qualify, their application will be invalid and they will not be included.

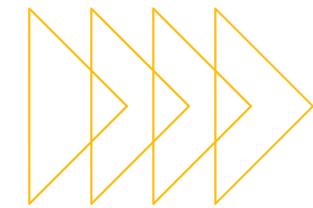

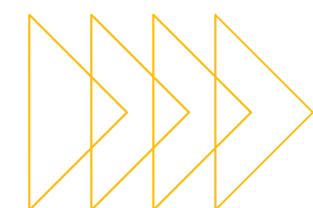
Any student returning for the fall 2026 semester, who is planning to live on campus in a residence hall, must participate in **Housing Selection Night** on Thursday, April 23rd.

Complete Fall 26 Housing Intent Form



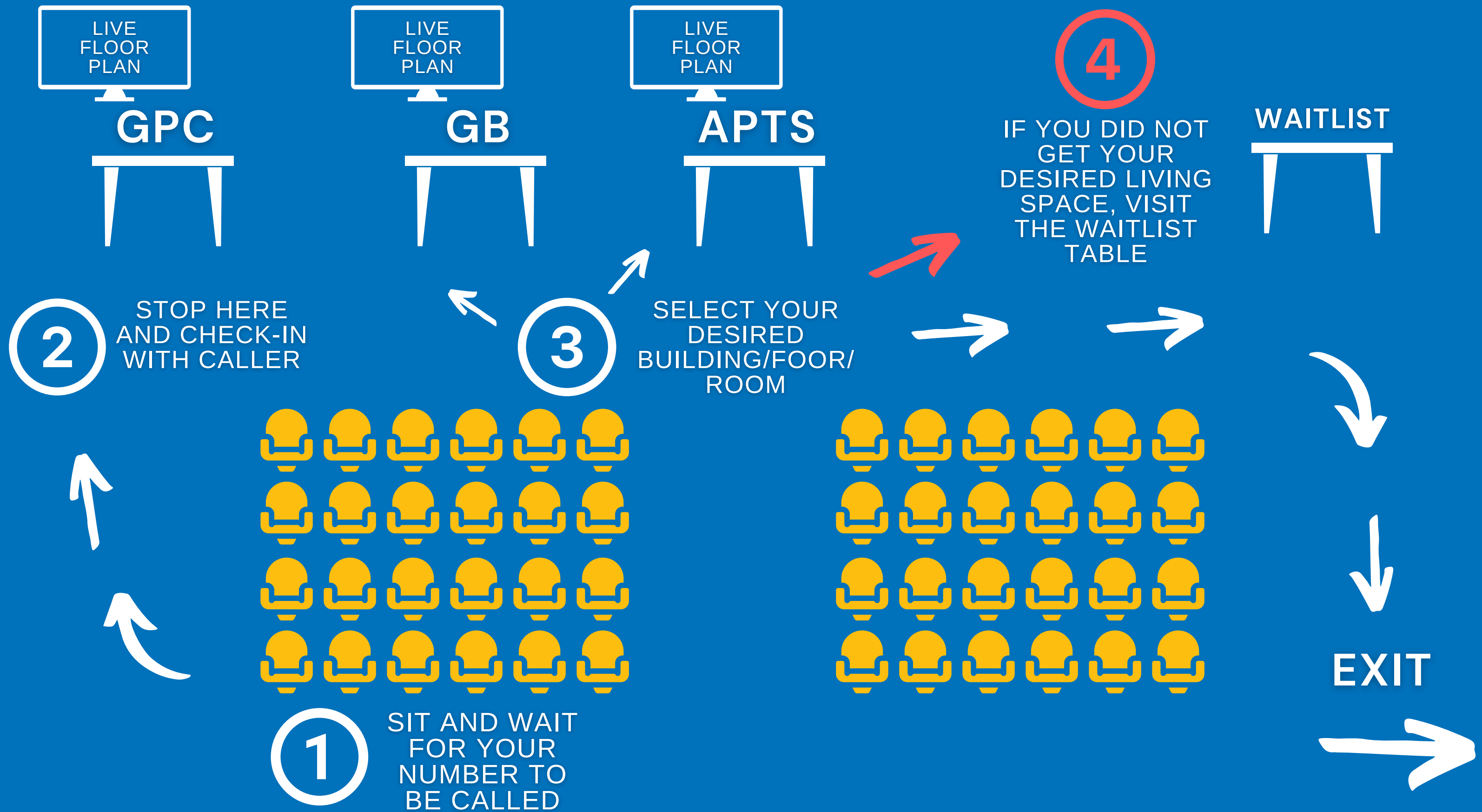
To be invited to Housing Selection Night, you must fill out the Fall 26 Housing Intent Form by **Thursday, April 16th at noon**.

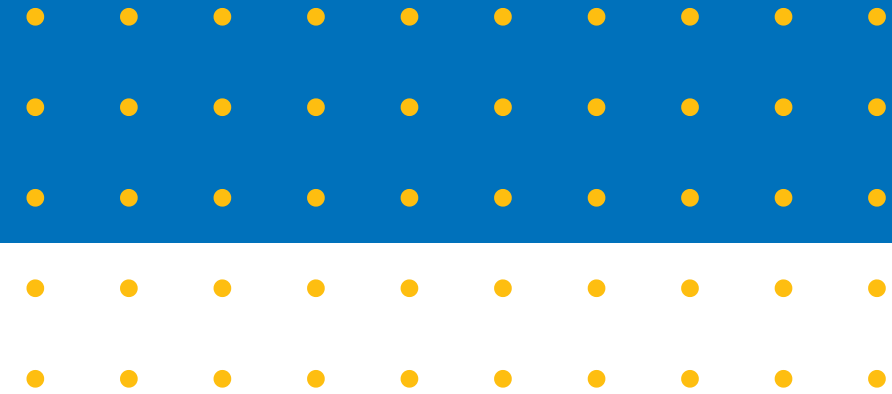

GRADUATE STUDENT HOUSING OPTIONS

OPTION 1

Graduate Housing in Building C (Cost: \$3900)

- Live with other single graduates only
- No meal plan required (can opt-in as desired)
- Can provide roommate requests and we will do our best to honor those. You will not go through the Housing Selection Night process.
- MIT students: provided the extended stay without having to follow the summer housing process, will just stay in their current spot (cost is half summer rent)

OPTION 2

Mixed Housing with Undergraduates in Student Apartments (Cost: \$4720)

- Students can room with traditional undergraduate students and participate in the Housing Selection Night process at a “**senior**” level for points
- Placement is **NOT** guaranteed (ie: if you do not make it based on point level, you do not get in).
- Required to have a meal plan.
- Would follow summer housing processes for an extended stay which would include movement between apartments and residence halls on very specific dates (cost is half summer rent). Summer housing is not guaranteed; however, we don't anticipate an issue for summer 2025.

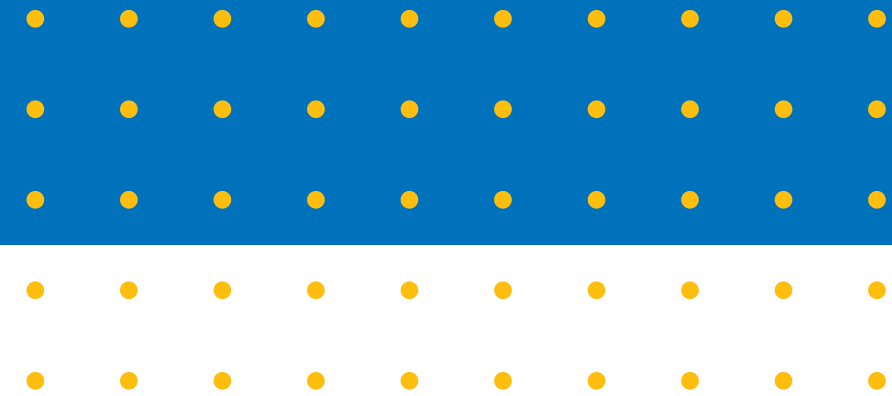

Live with Parents

If you can answer **yes** to one of these:

If you can only answer yes to living with parents, please fill out the **parental verification form & proof of address**

Complete the Off-Campus Request Application through MyHousing

Mark "applying to live off campus" on your housing intent form

You may choose a room in a residence hall in case your application is not approved

If you **cannot** answer **yes** to one of these:

You will be invited to select a room during Housing Selection Night

Wait for an approval or denial email
