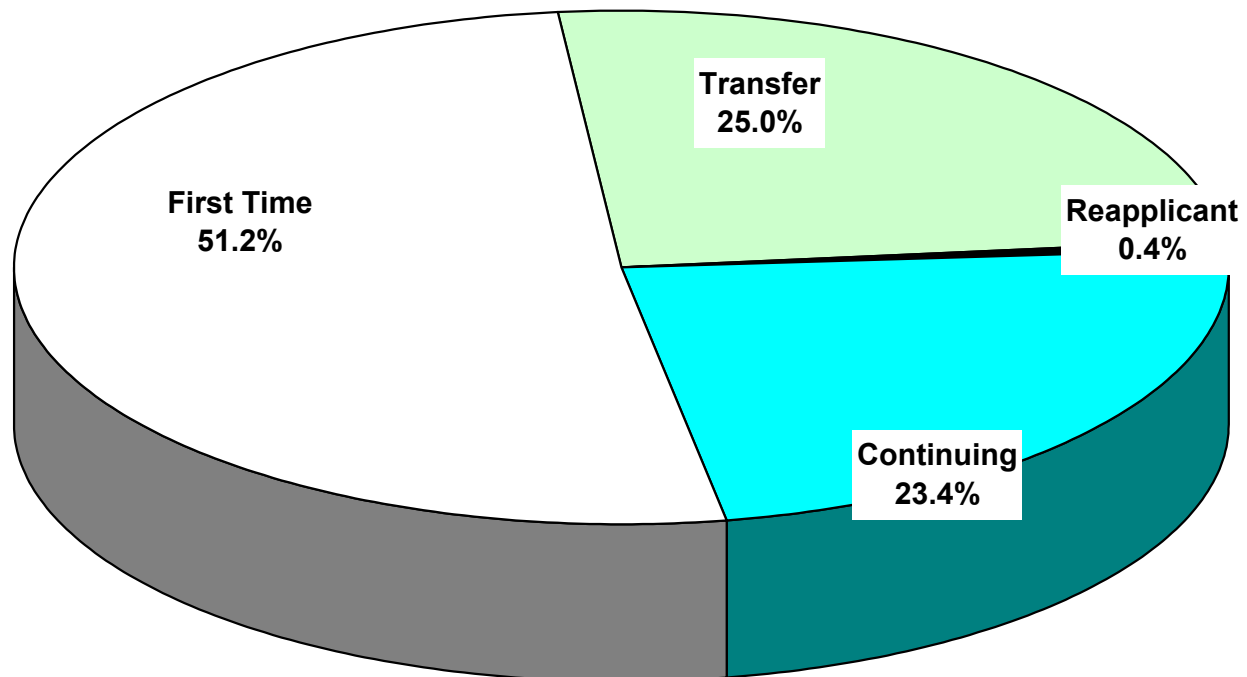

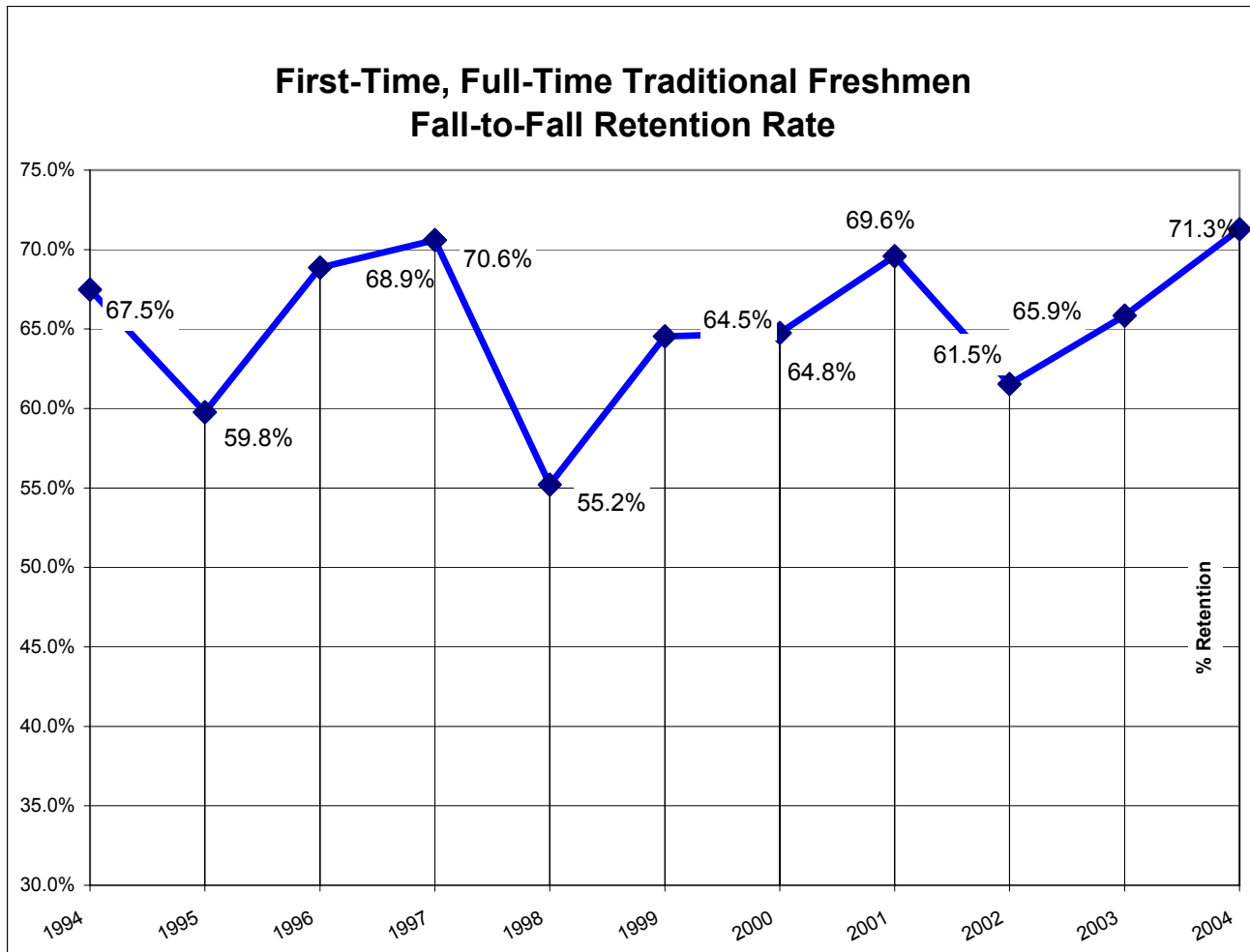

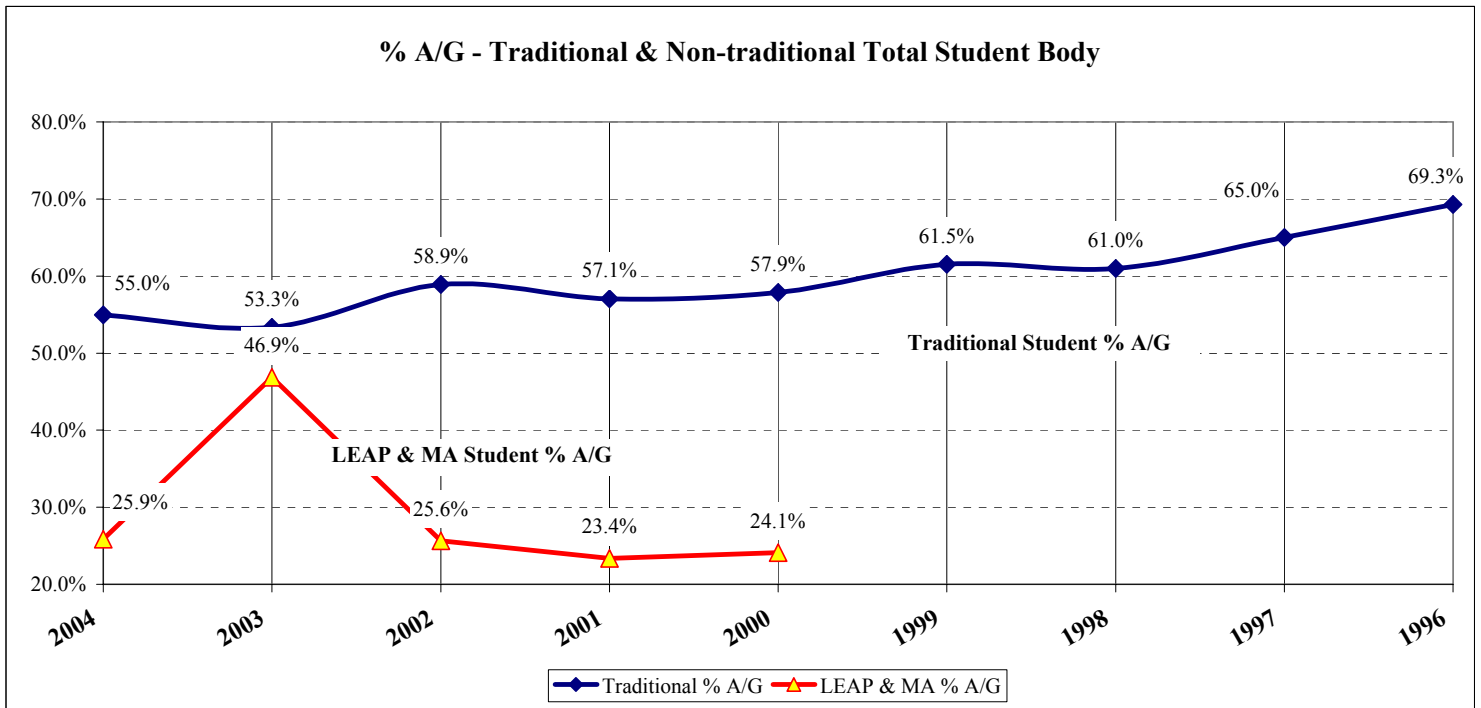

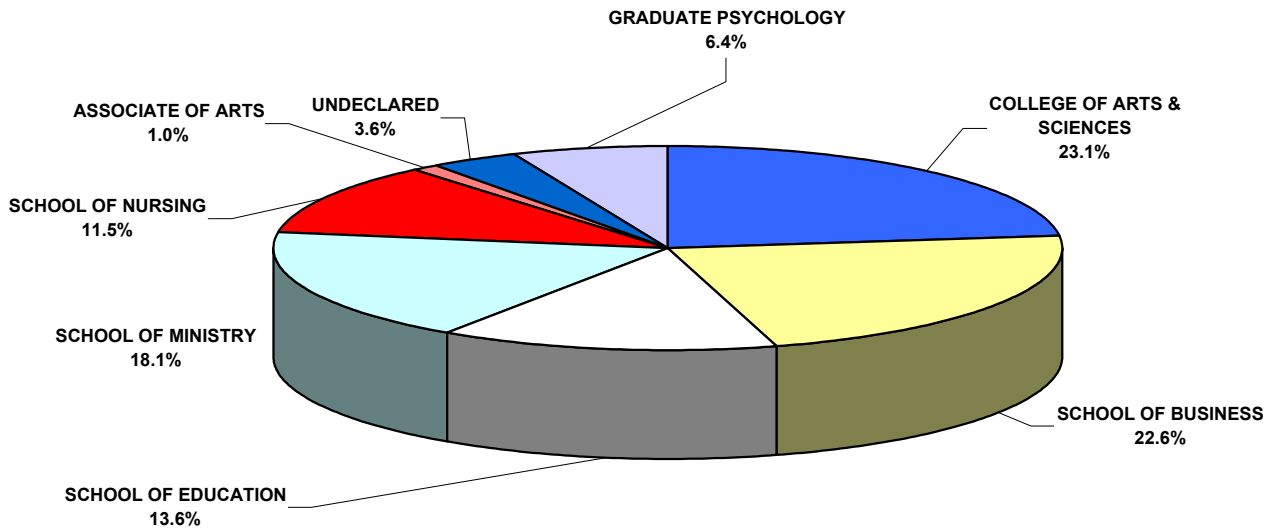

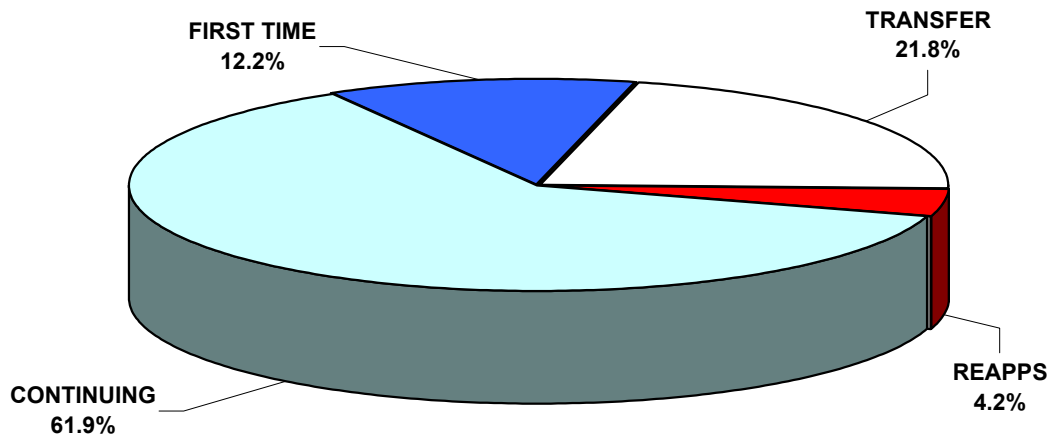

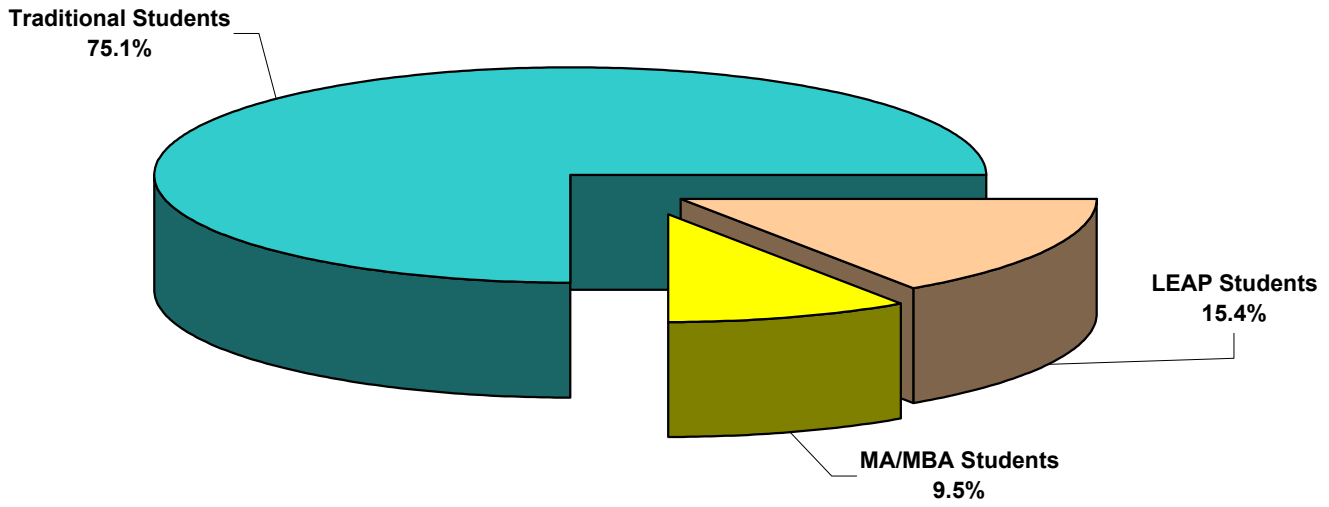
Enrollment by Class



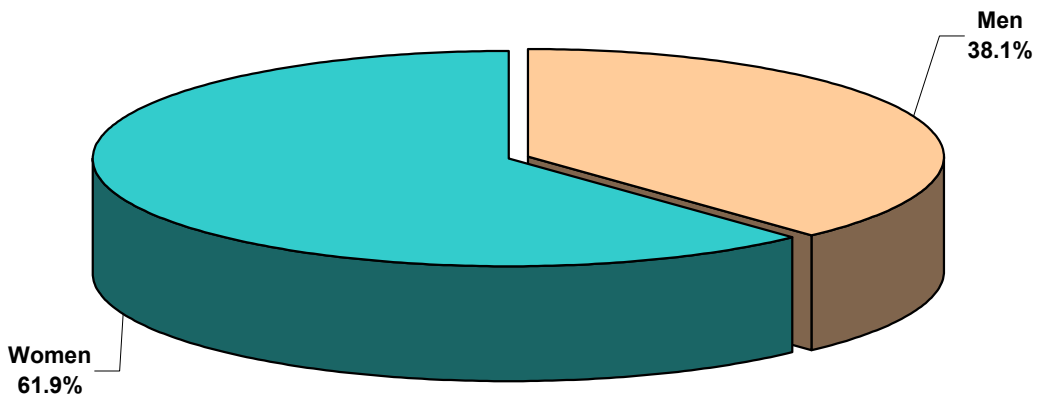
Enrollment by Status
