Inspiring and Pastoral Leadership

- Casts Biblical vision for engagement with local and global missions in chapel and other events, and through various forms of communication
- Promotes local and global missions opportunities to the campus
- Prepares a brief presentation related to the giving focus in gatherings

Recruiting

- Recruits club leaders and members for current local missions teams (Lighthouse, Embargo, etc.)
- Recruits a missions team to support missions through event help and prayer
- Recruits team leaders and members for global/domestic missions trips

Team-building

- Provides leadership and direction to individual local missions team leaders
- Encourages and helps Global/Domestic Missions team leaders as they recruit team members, build team dynamics, and prepare for their trips

Event Planning/Administration

- Searches for and implements new endeavors that serve the local community (Kirkland, Seattle, etc.)
- Assists in planning and implementation of various missions-related events (Local Outreach Week, Global Missions Info Night, fundraisers, etc.)
- Leads a global/domestic missions trip in the summer (winter/spring are also possible)
- Makes sure that the giving is set-up and collected in chapel
- Meets weekly with Pastor Micah
- Holds office hours (TBD)
