Mosaic Student Director Overview:

The Mosaic Student Director is a leader of leaders. As the Student Director, you will help implement the mission and vision of multicultural life on campus. You will lead a small team of student leaders (4-6) empowering them to grow in faith and develop in character. You will responsibly gain insight from student voices (many underrepresented) and in turn share that voice with the broader NU population, primarily through campus programming. You will embody servant leadership as you serve your team, NU, and the surrounding community. This position is supervised by the Director of Multicultural Life.

Responsibilities/Requirements:

- Demonstrate cultural humility-being “other” oriented
- Lead weekly Mosaic general meetings and office hours
- Meet weekly with Director of Multicultural Life to plan and develop programming
- Implement vision and mission of Multicultural Life at NU
- Welcome the responsibility as becoming the face of Mosaic
- Be willing to facilitate hard conversations with understanding and compassion amongst your team and the NU student body
- Lead by example to identify, respect and celebrate all cultures (especially those represented at NU)
- At times attend ancillary events on campus and off, as deemed by Director of Multicultural Life (e.g. community meetings, student representative meetings, conferences, etc.)
- Foster campus collaboration (departments, student groups, faculty, etc.)
- Help build team dynamics (serve each team member)
- Actively recruit interested NU students to events and future leadership
- Help create and typically lead Mosaic events (Courageous Conversations, Multicultural Week, etc.)
- Strong communication with Mosaic team, Director of Multicultural Life, various staff/faculty, student body
- Regularly meet 1:1 with Mosaic student coordinators and potential Mosaic volunteers
- Additional work/hours will be directed by the Director of Multicultural Life and demand of that week’s programming preparation

This position averages 10 hours of work per week. Hours need to be flexible and additional hours may be required on event days.



Qualifications:

- Demonstrate a strong commitment to the Christian faith and the values of Northwest University
- Demonstrate an understanding of leadership and have a desire to grow personally and professionally
- Strong in communication and comfortable with public speaking
- Ability to effectively delegate responsibilities and motivate peers to success
- Be a full-time student at Northwest University (at least 12 hours/semester) throughout position
- Must be in good standing with Student Development, Campus Ministries and the Office of the Provost
- Maintain a minimum cumulative and semester grade point average of 2.50
- Additional paid jobs must not exceed 20 hours, unless otherwise approved by the Director of Multicultural Life
- Must be of Sophomore status prior to leadership and must have been enrolled as a full-time student at
- Northwest University for at least two semesters prior to the term of leadership

Compensation:

The Mosaic Student Director will receive a scholarship of \$4,830.00 per year (\$2,415.00 per semester)
