Life Group Responsibilities

- Recruit and pastor Life Group leaders
- Meet with Life Group leaders to bring pastoral care and support
- Oversee the Life Group leader application process
- Oversee administration of Life Groups in Campus Groups/NU Connect

Prayer Responsibilities

- Partners with Campus Pastors in leading Prayer for our community
- Recruit and pastor Prayer Team members
- Creates and maintains database of praise reports and student testimonies
- Builds prayer teams to be available in gatherings
- Speaks and pastors in gatherings when needed
- Alongside Campus Pastors, oversees Prayer Number

Hours & Scholarship

- 8 hours per week (on average)
