Mosaic Student Media Coordinator Overview:

The Mosaic Student Media Coordinator is gifted in creativity and experienced in utilizing a variety of media applications. As the Media Coordinator, you will focus on promotion and create unique branding for the Mosaic team.

As a member of Mosaic, you will responsibly gain insight from student voices (many underrepresented) and in turn share that voice with the broader NU population. You will creatively implement cocurricular programming both active and passive. You will embody servant leadership as you engage NU and the surrounding community.

This position is supervised by the Director of Multicultural Life.

Responsibilities/Requirements:

- Actively manage Mosaic's Instagram and other social media accounts. This includes creating a social media presence and a place for students to learn/engage in multiculturalism
- Create posters, ads, and other forms of promotion directed towards the NU community
- Work within deadlines to ensure forms or promos are submitted in a timely manner
- Assist in envisioning event aesthetics and making that vision a reality
- Facilitate or assist in moderating events, as needed
- Participate in all weekly Mosaic team meetings and office hours
- Assist in coordination and execution of events/programs
- Foster campus collaboration (departments, student organizations, clubs, faculty, etc.)
- Help build team dynamics (serve each team member)
- Actively recruit interested NU students to programs/events and potential future leadership
- Develop relationships with Mosaic team, Director of Multicultural Life, various staff/faculty, student body
- Consistently meet with Director of Multicultural Life throughout the semester
- Regularly meet with Mosaic Student Director and potential Mosaic volunteers
- Additional work hours will be directed by the Director of Multicultural Life and demand of that week's programming preparation
- Mandatory participation in campus programming through attendance and volunteerism, as needed (Welcome Weekend, Family Weekend, and CSLC).

This position averages 5.5 hours of work per week.



Qualifications:

- Demonstrate a strong commitment to the Christian faith and the values of Northwest University
- Demonstrate cultural humility-focusing on elevating others and displaying a posture of constant learning
- Demonstrate an understanding of leadership and have a desire to grow personally and professionally
- Strong in communication and comfortable with public speaking
- Be a full-time student at Northwest University (at least 12 hours/semester) throughout position
- Must be in good standing with Student Development, Campus Ministries, and the Office of the Provost
- Maintain a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.5
- Additional paid jobs must not exceed 20 hours, unless otherwise approved by the Director of Multicultural Life
- Must be of Sophomore status prior to leadership and must have been enrolled as a full-time student at Northwest University for at least two semesters prior to the term of leadership

Compensation:

This position will receive a 7.75% tuition scholarship. Based on the 2025-2026 tuition, this is \$2,837.00.
